Lunazul silver tequila, Cointreau, fresh blood orange, lime, shaken & served on the rocks with a salt rim

Italian Greyhound

Portland Potato vodka, Campari, grapefruit served on the rocks

Arancio Nero

Old Overholt rye whiskey, Averna Amaro, angostura and orange bitters, chilled & served up

Mushroom Espresso Martini

House infused mushroom vodka, Kahlua, vanilla liqueur, espresso, served up

Sticky Stigma

Appleton's aged rum, house made Tepache, honey syrup, Orgeat, lime, shaken & topped with chile oil drizzle & fresh lime wedge

Blueberry Basil Equinox

House infused blueberry vodka, St. Germain, basil, lime, shaken & served up.

Humblebrag

Beefeater gin, honey, lemon, served over a big rock & topped with prosecco.

Empress Collins

Empress 1908 Indigo gin, St. Germain, lemon, simple, shaken & topped with soda water.

Classic Mai Tai

Appleton's Aged Rum, house infused dry curacao, tiki bitters, Orgeat, lime.

Fury of Perpetua

Lunazul silver, Aperol, Lillet Blanc, passionfruit, and lime. Shaken & served up. For a kick, substitute house infused jalapeno tequila.

Pink Cloud

Lunazul Blanco tequila, Lillet Blanc, sumac, grapefruit, lemon, egg white, shaken & served up.

Rue's Revenge

Union Uno Mezcal, Lunazul Blanco, Lillet Blanc, Orgeat, house made prickly pear shrub, lime, topped with soda. For a spicy kick, substitute house infused spicy pepper tequila.

Earl Grey Old Fashioned

House infused Earl Grey bourbon, black walnut bitters, cherry, served over a big rock.

Four Roses Bourbon, Amaro Nonino, Aperol, lemon, shaken & served up

Early Drift Inn History

The Drift Inn (originally spelled Drift In) was built in 1929 with wood brought down the beach from Toledo. Guy Freehouse owned the place and so it was usually just referred to as "Guy's Place." During prohibition, the bar downstairs "shut down" and became an "ice cream parlor." Upstairs, though, one could still drink, dance, and play cards. It was also the center of the community, had pot-lucks, and was the place to bring elk and deer to be cured.
